The World Bank Group's, Compliance Advisor Ombudsman (CAO) in collaboration with African Network for Environment and Economic Justice (ANEEJ) and Global Rights invites you to participate in a video conference meeting with its team from Washington DC on the mandates and works of the World Bank Group in Nigeria.

The CAO is an independent mechanism that responds to complaints from local communities about private sector projects financed by the International Finance Corporation (IFC) and/or Multilateral Development Guarantee Agency (MIGA) which are the private sector arms of the World Bank Group. Local communities have a right to access CAO's services, which include dispute resolution and investigation, to help address social and/or environmental harms related to IFC and MIGA-supported development projects in their locality.
